RK11	<p>Prepared Public Speaking - English Home Language</p> <p>(Preferably school uniform, otherwise plain black drama outfit with skirts for girls)</p> <p>The participant will give an argumentative speech, stating his opinion for or against a subject. Own choice. This is a speech to convince, not a lecture. A speech that has previously been adjudicated may be used.</p> <p>The adjudicator may <u>not</u> be confronted if the outcome of the adjudication differs from previous adjudication. Remember, adjudicators and adjudication differ. Cue cards may be used.</p> <p>Gr 1 – Gr 3: 2 - 4 min Gr 4 - 7: 3 - 6 min Gr 8-12: 7 min</p>
RK12	<p>Prepared Public Speaking - English First Additional Language</p> <p>(Preferably school uniform, otherwise plain black drama outfit with skirts for girls)</p> <p>The participant will give an argumentative speech, stating his opinion for or against a subject. RK14	<p>Unprepared Public Speaking</p> <p>(Preferably school uniform, otherwise plain black drama outfit with skirts for girls)</p> <p>A topic will be given by the adjudicator 5 minutes prior to participating. Cue cards may be used. Pupils may not sit in the audience before performance or leave the venue after performance.</p> <p>Gr 1 – Gr 7: 7 - 12 min Gr 8 - 12: 10 - 12 min</p>

RKG11	<p>Prepared Team Public Speaking</p> <p>(Preferably school uniform, otherwise black drama outfit with skirts for girls)</p> <p>The group will give an argumentative speech, stating his opinion for or against a subject. Own choice. This is a speech to convince, not a lecture.</p> <p>A speech that has previously been adjudicated may be used. The adjudicator may <u>not</u> be confronted if the outcome of the adjudication differs from previous adjudication.
